- What should I expect? Expect to have a great time! We are so excited to do this with you!
- What's a Sew-cial? Our Sew-cial event is another term for a sewing retreat! We come together to sew, socialize, get inspired, and work on our own projects.
- Who can attend? We encourage everyone from confident beginners to seasoned sewers to attend the event!

You will be at your own station, working at your own pace, and working on the project(s) you bring.

Any cancellations made less than a week of the event will be transferred to the next in line on the waitlist. If your cancellation is not filled by the waitlist, a refund will not be issued.
- Can I rent a machine? Although we usually offer the option to use a machine for a class, we encourage that you bring your own machine for the retreat.
- Will you secure our belongings?
