

Using the Star 60 Ruler with Anne, Class #1 - Hextravaganza

I am so excited you're joining us for this class. The pattern we will be covering is included with your Star 60 ruler, "Hextravaganza". Please be sure to bring the tool instructions with you to class. If you've misplaced the instructions, you can download a copy from the Studio 180 website (<https://studio180design.net/pages/free-downloads>). You can also print your own blank copy of the quilt to audition colors from the "Assorted Downloads" section further down that same page.

For this quilt, you will need 3 fabrics for the main body (2 fabrics for the star points and 1 fabric for background) and 2 fabrics for the borders. The approximate finished size is 36" (depending on your final border sizes). Please cut the indicated strips prior to coming to class.

Please bring the following to class:

- Sewing Machine and manual (machine should be in good working order, with proper tension and even stitch) with a 1/4" foot or seam guid
- Rotary Cutter - 45mm with a new blade (As a safety precaution during class, all rotary cutters must be closed when not in use)
- Quilters pins or wonder clips
- Thread - Aurifil 50 weight cotton thread is recommended
- Bobbins - wind at least 2 bobbins prior to class

Required items for class:

- Deb Tucker's Studio 180 Star 60 tool, including the instructions that came with it
- True Grip, Invisagrip and Ruler stickers (optional)
- Power Strip 60 Technique Sheet
- 6" x 24" (approx) regular straight ruler
- Fabric Marking pencil or pen of your choice for use on the back of your main fabrics

Fabric requirements and cutting:

Fabric	Amount Needed	Strips to Cut (Quantity) - Size to cut
A (used for star points)	1/3 yd	(2) - 2 1/2" (1) - 4 1/2"
B (used for star points)	1/3 yd	(2) - 2 1/2" (1) - 4 1/2"
Background	1 yd	(2) - 2 3/4" (2) - 3 1/2" (2) - 2 1/2" (1) - 10"
Inner Border	1/4 yd	(4) - 2"
Outer Border	1/2 yd	(4) - 3 1/2"

You will receive a 20% discount for items needed for this class and 10% discount on the day of this class. If you have questions about the supplies, please stop by or call the store (412) 767-5500. **If you need to reserve a classroom sewing machine, please do so at least 24 hours in advance so we can have one setup in time for class.**
