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Using the Star 60 Ruler with Anne, Class #2—Snow Crystal

Let's expand your knowledge of the Star 60 tool by making holiday table topper or tree skirt using the Studio 180 Snow Crystal pattern. In addition to reviewing the basic Star 60 unit, you will also learn how to make Quad 60 and Capped 60 units with Deb Tucker's Studio 180 Star 60 tool. The directions for these additional units are included with the pattern, but if you'd like to make them in other sizes in the future, you will find the optional Technique Sheets very useful.

For this project, you will need 3 coordinating fabrics plus a background fabric. Please refer to the pattern for total yardage needed and fabric placement. We will be making the small version of the pattern, which finishes at 32".

Please bring the following to class:

- ♦ Sewing Machine and manual (machine should be in good working order with proper tension and even stitch) with a 1/4" foot or seam guide
- ♦ Rotary Cutter—45 mm with a new blade (as a safety precaution during class, all blades must be closed when not in use)
- Quilters pins or wonder clips
- ♦ Thread—Aurifil 50 weight cotton thread is recommended
- ♦ Bobbins—wind at least 2 bobbins prior to class

Required Items for Class:

- ♦ Deb Tucker's Studio 180 Star 60 tool, including the instructions
- ♦ True Grip, Invisagrip and Ruler Stickers (optional)
- ♦ Studio 180's Snow Crystal pattern
- ♦ Capped 60 Technique Sheet (optional)
- ♦ Quad 60 Technique Sheet (optional)

Fabric Requirements and cutting: (WOF means Width of Fabric)

Fabric	Strips to cut (Quantity) - Size
A (Red in photo) Inner Border:	(2) 2 3/4" X WOF (3) 1 1/2" x WOF, cut in half on the fold
B (Dark Green in photo)	(1) 2 3/4" x WOF (1) 3" x WOF
C (Medium Green in photo) Inner Border:	(2) 2 3/4 x WOF (1) 3" x WOF (3) 3 1/2 x WOF, cut in half on the fold
Background	(3) 3" x WOF (1) 4 1/2" x WOF
