

Using the Star 60 Ruler with Anne, Class #3 - Hollow Cubes

In this class, we will explore how to make a 15" Hollow Cube-in-a-Hollow-Cube, using Deb Tucker's Studio 180 Star 60 tool and the Hollow Cube Technique Sheet.

For this project, you will need 3 fabrics - a light, medium and dark - that have a great deal of contrast. This is a good time to pull out those solids or reads-as-solids fabrics for the best results. You don't need to use fabrics in the same colorway, just as long as there is a good light, medium and dark contrast.

Please bring the following to class:

- O Sewing Machine and manual (machine should be in good working order, with proper tension and even stitch) with a 1/4" foot or seam guid
- O Rotary Cutter 45mm with a new blade (As a safety precaution during class, all rotary cutters must be closed when not in use)
- O Quilters pins or wonder clips
- O Thread Aurifil 50 weight cotton thread is recommended
- O Bobbins wind at least 2 bobbins prior to class

Required items for class:

- O Deb Tucker's Studio 180 Star 60 tool, including the instructions that came with it
- O True Grip, Invisagrip and Ruler stickers (optional)
- Hollow Cube Technique Sheet

Fabric requirements and cutting:

You will need 1/3 yd of each fabric. Please cut the following pieces **FROM EACH FABRIC** prior to class.

Cut	Strips to Cut (Quantity) - Size to cut
	(1) - 2 1/4" x wof - subcut into at least 12 triangles (1) - 3" x wof - subcut into at least 2 triangles
For Frames:	(2) - 1 1/4" x wof (1) - 2 1/4" x wof

You will receive a 20% discount for items needed for this class and 10% discount on the day of this class. If you have questions about the supplies, please stop by or call the store (412) 767-5500. If you need to reserve a classroom sewing machine, please do so at least 24 hours in advance so we can have one setup in time for class.
