

All The Things Tote with Missy

This is a great advanced beginner sewing project. Learn how to create the All The Things Tote by Knot & Thread with guidance from skilled instructor Missy. In this class you will learn how to create this perfectly sized tote bag, and The Quilting Needle has everything you need to create it!

General Supplies

- 1) **Sewing Machine & Manual** (machine should be in good working order, with proper tension and even stitch)
 - 2) **Scissors** – small shear with a sharp tip, four to five inches long
 - 3) **Rotary Cutter*** – 45mm with a new blade and a bring a replacement blade (As a safety precaution during class, all rotary cutters must be closed when not in use.)
 - 4) **¼" Foot or seam guide** - for accurate seam allowances
 - 5) **Extra-long, fine quilter's pin***
 - 6) **Acrylic Ruler*** – with 1/8" increments for checking seam allowances
 - 7) **Thread*** – matching Aurifil 50 weight cotton thread
 - 8) **Bobbins** – wind at least three bobbins prior to class with thread for your project
- *or recommended item per class**

Specific Supplies for this class

- * Marking tool
- * Stiletto
- * Pins & wonder clips
- * All The Things Tote Pattern by Knot & Thread
- * 1yd Main Fabric (non-directional recommended)
- * 1yd of lining fabric (non-directional recommended)
- * 1/2yd of accent fabric for binding
- * 1 3/4 yd of 1.5" webbing—we will not be covering, so pick matching or complimentary webbing
- * 36" bosal or package of soft & stable



Prior to class Prep Work

Quilt main fabric, lining fabric and Bosal or soft and stable as per the pattern instructions for large size.

- cut out quilted pieces for main bag, 2sides and 2 pockets

If you want to use directional fabric you may need additional fabric. You will need to cut two pieces and seam prior to quilting fabric for the main bag, the seam will be center bottom. Pay attention to direction on sides and pockets also.

You will receive a 20% discount for items needed for this class and 10% discount on the day of this class.
