

## Radiance Quilt with Anne

In this 3-part class, we will cover all of the Studio 180 tools needed to make the Radiance quilt. This class will be a great refresher for using tools that you might not have used in awhile as well as adding new ones to your quilting tool box. This is a stunning quilt to use year-round, or to make in seasonal fabrics for a special holiday quilt. This class is geared for advanced beginners with some knowledge of Studio 180 tools. Knowledge of ALL of the needed tools for this project is not required.

For this 67" x 67" quilt, you will need 11 different fabrics plus background fabric. Refer to your purchased pattern for the quantities of each fabric needed for this quilt. During class, we will work on making the various units in this quilt and there will be homework between each class.

### Please bring the following to class:

- Sewing Machine and manual (machine should be in good working order, with proper tension and even stitch) with a 1/4" foot or seam guide
- Rotary Cutter - 45mm with a new blade (As a safety precaution during class, all rotary cutters must be closed when not in use)
- Quilters pins or wonder clips
- Thread - Aurifil 50 weight cotton thread is recommended
- Bobbins - wind at least 2 bobbins prior to class
- Straight-edge ruler

### Required items for class:

- Deb Tucker's Studio 180 tools and the directions that came with them:
  - Corner Beam (1st class)
  - V Block (1st class)
  - Corner Pop I (2nd class)
  - Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star (2nd class)
  - Tucker Trimmer III (2nd class)
- Deb Tucker's Studio 180 Radiance Pattern
- True Grip or Invisagrip and Ruler stickers (optional)

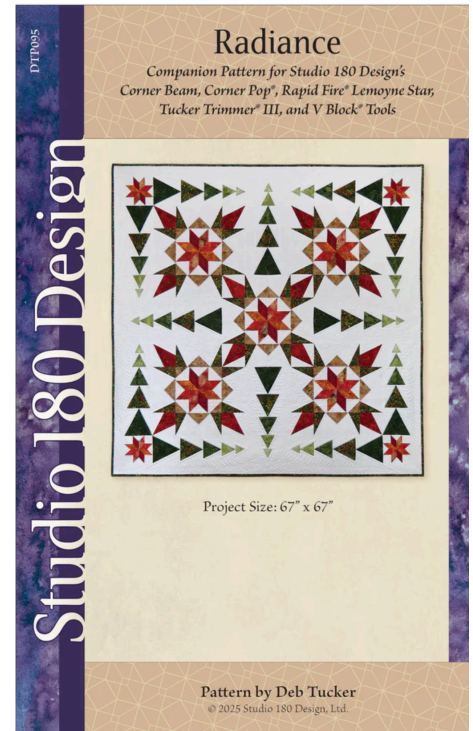
If you've misplaced the instructions of the Studio 180 tools, you can download a copy from the Studio 180 website (<https://studio180design.net/pages/free-downloads>).

If you need to reserve a classroom sewing machine, please do so at least 24 hours in advance so we can have one setup in time for class.

## **Fabric Requirements and Cutting**

This project uses many different fabrics to achieve its design. You are free to use your own color palette for your project, just make sure to keep track of which fabric you are substituting. I've included a column for your fabric choices in the **2-page** chart below. I've only included what you need to cut to make the units we will make during class. **Please refer to the pattern's cutting directions for additional cutting that is needed to complete the project.** We will also cover the additional cutting requirements during our first class. WOF means Width of Fabric. You may find it very helpful to label the size of your strips prior to class.,
