

# OXBOW TOTE

## Pattern By Noodlehead with Missy



Hartwood Towne Centre  
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This is a 3-4 hour class with prep work required prior to class. In class you will be making the regular sized tote.

### General Supplies

- 1) **Sewing Machine & Manual** (machine should be in good working order, with proper tension and even stitch)
- 2) **Scissors** – small shear with a sharp tip, four to five inches long
- 3) **Rotary Cutter\*** – 45mm with a new blade and a bring a replacement blade (As a safety precaution during class, all rotary cutters must be closed when not in use.)
- 4) **Universal machine foot** - for accurate seam allowances
- 5) **Extra-long, fine quilter's pin\***
- 6) **Acrylic Ruler\*** – with 1/8" increments for checking seam allowances
- 7) **Thread\*** – matching Aurifil 50 weight cotton thread
- 8) **Bobbins** – wind at least three bobbins prior to class with thread for your project

### Specific Supplies for this class

- Oxbow Tote pattern by Noodlehead
- Supplies as per back of pattern for desired Size
  - Fabric as per pattern - please read recommended fabrics at bottom of pattern back
  - Pellon 810 Tru-Grid 1" Pattern Ease—use this to trace the pattern pieces
  - stabilizer (Bosal or Soft and Stable or fusible fleece)
  - interfacing (SF101 or similar)
  - Webbing as per pattern
  - Zipper as per pattern - if using zipper by the yard refer to note at bottom of pattern back
  - bag hardware - (2) 1"-1.5" d rings or triangle rings, (2) 1.5" strap swivel hooks, (1) 1.5" strap slider
- pins, wonder clips, marking tool, thread and wound bobbins to pin matching or contrasting threads color, size 14 or 16 denim microtex needle for sewing machine
- *Optional: stiletto and basting tape*

### Prior to class Prep Work

- Read through your pattern—Use Pellon 810 Tru-Grid pattern ease to trace the pattern pieces for cutting
  - Cut out all pieces as per pages 3-4 - see cutting layouts on pages 5-9
  - Quilt outer fabric if desired as per page 4 - I did quilt the canvas/cotton on my bags, do not quilt waxed canvas for outer.
- \*\*You may choose to quilt the lining or stabilize with Sf101 or decor bond interfacing to give more body to the bag, this will need to be done prior to the class
- complete the prepare section on page 10 prior to class, we will begin at step 1 on page 10 in class



You will receive a 20% discount for items needed for this class and 10% discount on the day of this class. If you have questions about the supplies, please stop by or call the store (412) 767-5500. **If you need to reserve a classroom sewing machine, please do so at least 24 hours in advance so we can have one setup in time for class.**
