

## **Pente with Anne**

Would you like to learn how to use the latest tool from Studio 180, the Nine Patch Square up? Then be sure to sign up for our Pente class. We'll explore the use of this new tool while making a Pente quilt. You can make any of the pattern's sizes for your project. In class, we'll work on several of the units to get you started and comfortable with the tool. This quilt makes a great baby blanket in softer colors or a very bold, modern statement with vibrant colors - it's completely up to you!

This is a great class for confident beginners who would like to improve their piecing skills. You should be comfortable using a straight-edge ruler with a rotary cutter and cutting strips of fabric for this class.

### **Please bring the following to class:**

- Sewing Machine and manual (machine should be in good working order, with proper tension and even stitch) with a 1/4" foot or seam guide
- Rotary Cutter - 45mm with a new blade (As a safety precaution during class, all rotary cutters must be closed when not in use)
- Quilters pins or wonder clips
- Thread - Aurifil 50 weight cotton thread is recommended
- Bobbins - wind at least 2 bobbins prior to class
- Straight-edge ruler
- Pencil

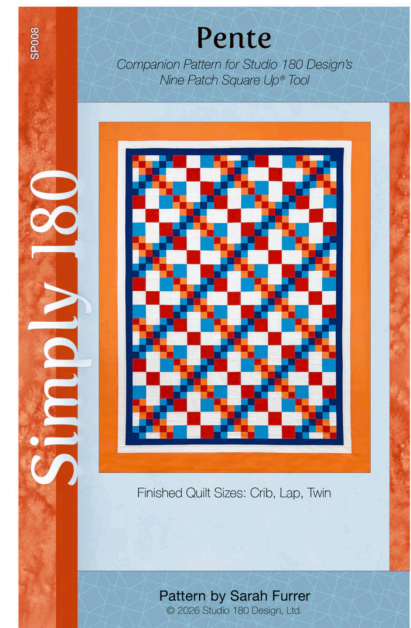
### **Required items for class:**

- Deb Tucker's Studio 180 Nine Patch Square Up tool and the directions that came with it
- Deb Tucker's Studio 180 Pente Pattern
- True Grip or Invisagrip and Ruler stickers (optional)

### **Fabric Requirements:**

In this class, you can make the size you'd like so the fabric requirements will differ. The Fabric Requirement chart and quilt sizes are on the next page of this supply list. You may want to considering purchasing a small amount more to allow for miscuts while learning the process. You may also pick any fabric combinations you'd like - this is YOUR quilt!



You will receive a 20% discount for items needed for this class and 10% discount on the day of this class. If you have questions about the supplies, please stop by or call the store (412) 767-5500. **If you need to reserve a classroom sewing machine, please do so at least 24 hours in advance so we can have one setup in time for class.**

Finished Quilt Sizes: Crib (38" x 54"), Lap (54" x 70"),  
and Twin (70" x 102")

Nine Patches create an interlocking design of crossing colors. Combining two different unit sizes causes you to look again to find where your units are in the quilt.

### Fabric Requirements

Based on 40" of usable fabric with few cutting errors. Please plan accordingly.

Fabric	Crib	Lap	Twin
Dark Orange	½ yard	1 yard	2 yards
Medium Orange	1 yard	1½ yards	2½ yards
Dark Blue	½ yard	¾ yard	1¼ yards
Medium Blue	½ yard	1 yard	1½ yards
Background	1 yard	1½ yards	3 yards
Binding	½ yard	½ yard	¾ yard
Backing	2¾ yards	3½ yards	6½ yards
