

## **Framed 60 Stars with Anne**

In this one part class, you will learn to use the Studio 180 Star 60 tool and Framed 60 Technique Sheet to make a Framed 60 unit. We will discuss how to combine more units into a tablerunner or other project you may want to make later. This is a technique-focused class and not a project-oriented one.

This is a great class for those who have used the Star 60 tool previously but would like to expand their use of the tool. Confident beginners who have used 60 degree triangles would also benefit. You should be comfortable using a rotary cutter.

### **Please bring the following to class:**

- Sewing Machine and manual (machine should be in good working order, with proper tension and even stitch) with a 1/4" foot or seam guide
- Rotary Cutter - 45mm with a new blade (As a safety precaution during class, all rotary cutters must be closed when not in use)
- Quilters pins or wonder clips
- Thread - Aurifil 50 weight cotton thread is recommended
- Bobbins - wind at least 2 bobbins prior to class
- Straight-edge ruler
- Pencil (for note-taking)

### **Required items for class:**

- Deb Tucker's Studio 180 Star 60 tool and the directions that came with it
- Deb Tucker's Studio 180 Framed 60 Technique Sheet
- Invisagrip strongly recommended for back of your tool
- Permanent marker for writing on the back of your tool. It can be erased with an alcohol wipe.
- Acorn Easy Press Pen (optional but can be very helpful maintaining center points)

### **Fabric Requirements:**

In this class, we will make 1 Framed Star 60 block. You can make as many as you need for your tablerunner at home. Fabric requirements on the following page indicate what is needed for class and what was used for the shown tablerunner. You may need more fabric if you decide to make a longer tablerunner or other project.

You will receive a 20% discount for items needed for this class and 10% discount on the day of this class. If you have questions about the supplies, please stop by or call the store (412) 767-5500. **If you need to reserve a classroom sewing machine, please do so at least 24 hours in advance so we can have one setup in time for class.**
